A BILL

To amend titles 10 and 38, United States Code, to authorize a person awarded the Medal of Honor to designate an individual to receive the special pension after death, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZING A PERSON AWARDED THE**
2 **MEDAL OF HONOR TO DESIGNATE AN INDI-**
3 **VIDUAL TO RECEIVE THE SPECIAL PENSION**
4 **AFTER DEATH.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1562 of title 38, United
6 States Code, is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a)—

8 (A) by striking “The Secretary” and in-
9 serting “(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Sec-
10 retary”; and

11 (B) by adding at the end the following new
12 paragraph:

13 “(2) A person described in paragraph (1) may des-
14 ignate an individual to receive the special pension under
15 this section after the death of that person by notifying
16 the Secretary of such designation in writing. In the case
17 of a Medal of Honor that is awarded posthumously, the
18 individual authorized under section 1482(c) of title 10 to
19 direct disposition of the remains of the person shall be
20 treated as such a designee.”;

21 (2) in subsection (d), by inserting “(or the des-
22 ignee of such person under subsection (a)(2))” be-
23 fore “shall not”; and

24 (3) in subsection (f)(1), by striking “person
25 who is in receipt of special pension payable under
26 this section” and inserting “person described in

1 paragraph (1) of subsection (a) (or the designee of
2 such a person under paragraph (2) of that sub-
3 section)”.

5 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 1134a of
6 title 10, United States Code, is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (c), by striking “living”; and

8 (2) in subsection (d), in the second sentence, by
9 inserting “(or the designee of that person under sub-
section (a)(2) of that section)” before the period.
