- 5 men Employment Preservation Act".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITING TREATMENT OF BLUEFIN TUNA AS
AN ENDANGERED SPECIES OR THREATENED
SPECIES.
Section 4(a) of the Endangered Species Act of 1973
is amended by adding at the end the following new para-
graph:
"(4) The Bluefin tuna may not be treated as an
endangered species or threatened species under this
Act.".
