Mr. YOHO (for himself and Mr. WALTZ) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend the Natural Gas Act to expedite approval of exports of small volumes of natural gas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Small Scale LNG Ac-
5 cess Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXPEDITED APPROVAL OF EXPORT OF CERTAIN**
7 **VOLUMES OF NATURAL GAS.**

8 Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. 717b)
9 is amended by striking subsection (c) and inserting the
10 following:

1 “(c) EXPEDITED APPLICATION AND APPROVAL
2 PROCESS.—

3 “(1) IN GENERAL.—For purposes of subsection
4 (a), the following shall be deemed to be consistent
5 with the public interest, and applications for such
6 importation or exportation shall be granted without
7 modification or delay:

8 “(A) The importation of the natural gas
9 referred to in subsection (b).

10 “(B) The exportation of natural gas in a
11 volume up to and including 51,750,000,000
12 cubic feet per year.

13 “(C) The exportation of natural gas to a
14 nation with which there is in effect a free trade
15 agreement requiring national treatment for
16 trade in natural gas.

17 “(2) EXCLUSION.—Subparagraphs (B) and (C)
18 of paragraph (1) shall not apply to any nation sub-
19 ject to sanctions imposed by the United States.”.

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
