A BILL

To reauthorize Department of Justice programs that combat violence against women, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Violence Against
3 Women Extension Act of 2021”.

4 **SEC. 2. STOP GRANTS.**

5 Section 1001(a)(18) of the Omnibus Crime Control
6 and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. 10261(a)(18)),
7 is amended by inserting after “for each of fiscal years
8 2014 through 2018” the following: “, and for fiscal year
9 2022”.

10 **SEC. 3. GRANTS TO ENCOURAGE ARREST POLICIES AND**
11 **ENFORCEMENT OF PROTECTION ORDERS.**

12 Section 1001(a)(19) of title I of the Omnibus Crime
13 Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C.
14 10261(a)(19)) is amended by inserting after “for each of
15 fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the following: “, and for
16 fiscal year 2022”.

17 **SEC. 4. LEGAL ASSISTANCE FOR VICTIMS.**

18 Section 1201(f)(1) of the Violence Against Women
19 Act of 2000 (34 U.S.C. 20121(f)(1)) is amended by insert-
20 ing after “for each of fiscal years 2014 through 2018”
21 the following: “, and for fiscal year 2022”.

22 **SEC. 5. GRANTS TO SUPPORT FAMILIES IN THE JUSTICE**
23 **SYSTEM.**

24 Section 1301(e) of the Violence Against Women Act
25 of 2000 (34 U.S.C. 12464(e)) is amended by inserting

1 after “for each of fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the
2 following: “, and for fiscal year 2022”.

3 **SEC. 6. SEX OFFENDER MANAGEMENT.**

4 Section 40152(e) of the Violence Against Women Act
5 of 1994 (34 U.S.C. 12311(c)) is amended by inserting
6 after “for each of fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the
7 following: “, and for fiscal year 2022”.

8 **SEC. 7. COURT-APPOINTED SPECIAL ADVOCATE PROGRAM.**

9 Section 219(a) the Crime Control Act of 1990 (42
10 U.S.C. 13014(a)) is amended by inserting after “for each
11 of fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the following: “, and
12 for fiscal year 2022”.

13 **SEC. 8. RURAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE,
14 SEXUAL ASSAULT, STALKING, AND CHILD
15 ABUSE ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE.**

16 Section 40295(e)(1) of the Violence Against Women
17 Act of 1994 (34 U.S.C. 12341(e)(1)) is amended by in-
18 serting after “for each of fiscal years 2014 through 2018”

22 Section 40801(b)(5) of the Violence Against Women

24 serting after “for each of fiscal years 2014 through 2018”
25 the following: “, and for fiscal year 2022”.

3 Section 304(e) of the Violence Against Women and
4 Department of Justice Reauthorization Act of 2005 (34

6 of fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the following: “, and
7 for fiscal year 2022”.

8 **SEC. 11. STUDY CONDUCTED THROUGH THE CENTERS FOR**
9 **DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION.**

10 Section 402(c) of the Violence Against Women and
11 Department of Justice Reauthorization Act of 2005 (42
12 U.S.C. 280b–4(c)) is amended by inserting after “for each
13 of the fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the following: “,
14 and for fiscal year 2022”.

15 **SEC. 12. SAVING MONEY AND REDUCING TRAGEDIES**
16 **THROUGH PREVENTION.**

17 Section 41303(f) of the Violence Against Women Act
18 of 1994 (34 U.S.C. 12463(f)) is amended by inserting
19 after “for each of fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the
20 following: “, and for fiscal year 2022”.

21 **SEC. 13. ADDRESSING THE HOUSING NEEDS OF VICTIMS OF**
22 **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE,**
23 **SEXUAL ASSAULT, AND STALKING.**

24 (a) **COLLABORATIVE GRANTS TO INCREASE THE**
25 **LONG-TERM STABILITY OF VICTIMS.**—Section 41404(i)
26 of the Violence Against Women Act of 1994 (34 U.S.C.

1 12474(i)) is amended by inserting after “for each of fiscal
2 years 2014 through 2018” the following: “, and for fiscal
3 year 2022,”.

4 (b) GRANTS TO COMBAT VIOLENCE AGAINST
5 WOMEN IN PUBLIC AND ASSISTED HOUSING.—Section
6 41405(g) of the Violence Against Women Act of 1994 (34
7 U.S.C. 12475(g)) is amended by inserting after “for each
8 of fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the following: “, and
9 for fiscal year 2022,”.

10 **SEC. 14. NATIONAL RESOURCE CENTER ON WORKPLACE**
11 **RESPONSES TO ASSIST VICTIMS OF DOMES-**
12 **TIC AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE.**

13 Section 41501(e) of the Violence Against Women Act
14 of 1994 (34 U.S.C. 12501(e)) is amended by inserting
15 after “for each of fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the
16 following: “, and for fiscal year 2022”.

17 **SEC. 15. GRANTS FOR TRIBAL JURISDICTION OVER CRIMES**
18 **OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.**

19 Section 204 of Public Law 90–284 (25 U.S.C. 1301
20 et seq.) (commonly known as the “Indian Civil Rights Act
21 of 1968”) is amended by inserting after “for each of fiscal
22 years 2014 through 2018” the following: “, and for fiscal
23 year 2022,”.

1 **SEC. 16. ANALYSIS AND RESEARCH ON VIOLENCE AGAINST**
2 **INDIAN WOMEN.**

3 Section 905(b)(2) of the Violence Against Women
4 and Department of Justice Reauthorization Act of 2005
5 (28 U.S.C. 534 note) is amended by inserting after “for
6 each of fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the following: “,
7 and for fiscal year 2022”.

8 **SEC. 17. STALKER DATABASE.**

9 Section 40603 of the Violence Against Women Act
10 of 1994 (34 U.S.C. 12402) is amended by inserting after
11 “for fiscal years 2014 through 2018” the following: “, and
12 for fiscal year 2022”.

13 **SEC. 18. FEDERAL VICTIM ASSISTANCE REAUTHORIZATION.**

25 for fiscal year 2022”.

1 **SEC. 20. TRAINING AND SERVICES TO END VIOLENCE**
2 **AGAINST PEOPLE WITH INDIVIDUALS.**

3 Section 1402(e) of division B of the Victims of Traf-
4 ficking and Violence Protection Act of 2000 (34 U.S.C.
5 20122(e)) is amended by inserting after “for each of fiscal
6 years 2014 through 2018” the following: “, and for fiscal
7 year 2022”.

8 **SEC. 21. SEXUAL ASSAULT SERVICES PROGRAM.**

9 Section 41601(f)(1) of the Violent Crime Control and
10 Law Enforcement Act of 1994 (34 U.S.C. 12511(f)(1))
11 is amended by inserting after “for each of fiscal years
12 2014 through 2018” the following: “, and for fiscal year
13 2022”.

14 **SEC. 22. RAPE SURVIVOR CHILD CUSTODY.**

15 Section 409 of the Justice for Victims of Trafficking
16 Act of 2015 (34 U.S.C. 21308) is amended by inserting
17 after “for each of fiscal years 2015 through 2019” the
18 following: “, and for fiscal year 2022”.

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
