AN ACT

To waive the passport fees for first responders proceeding abroad to aid a foreign country suffering from a natural disaster.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- ${\it 2\ tives\ of\ the\ United\ States\ of\ America\ in\ Congress\ assembled},$

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "First Responders Pass-
- 3 port Act of 2019".

4 SEC. 2. PASSPORTS FOR FIRST RESPONDERS.

- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (a) of section 1 of the
- 6 Act of June 4, 1920 (22 U.S.C. 214; 41 Stat. 750; com-
- 7 monly referred to as the "Passport Act of 1920"), is
- 8 amended, in the third sentence, by inserting after "to at-
- 9 tend a funeral or memorial service for such member;" the
- 10 following: "at the discretion of the Secretary, from an in-
- 11 dividual, including a volunteer, who is operating under a
- 12 contract, grant, or cooperative agreement with the United
- 13 States Government to proceed abroad within the first 7
- 14 days after a natural disaster to aid a foreign country suf-
- 15 fering from such natural disaster;".
- 16 (b) Report.—Not later than 90 days after the end
- 17 of the first full fiscal year after the date of the enactment
- 18 of this Act, the Secretary of State shall submit to the
- 19 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representa-
- 20 tives and the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Sen-
- 21 ate a report on the number of waivers of fees for the exe-
- 22 cution and issuance of passports to first responders under
- 23 section 1 of the Act of June 4, 1920, as amended by sub-
- 24 section (a) of this section, for such fiscal year.

1 SEC. 3. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

- 2 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
- 3 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
- 4 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
- 5 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this
- 6 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
- 7 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
- 8 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
- 9 vote on passage.
