To amend title 11, District of Columbia Official Code, to prohibit the exclusion of individuals from service on a District of Columbia jury on account of sexual orientation or gender identity.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “District of Columbia
5 Local Juror Non-Discrimination Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXCLUSION FROM DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA JURIES**
2 **ON ACCOUNT OF SEXUAL ORIENTATION OR**
3 **GENDER IDENTITY PROHIBITED.**

4 Section 11–1903, District of Columbia Official Code,
5 is amended by inserting “(including sexual orientation or
6 gender identity)” after “sex”.
