- 5 (a) In General.—Section 3304 of title 40, United
- 6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 7 lowing:
- 8 "(e) Leasing of Space for Securities and Ex-
- 9 CHANGE COMMISSION.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 10 sion of law, on and after the date of enactment of this

- 1 subsection, the Securities and Exchange Commission may
- 2 not lease general purpose office space. The Administrator
- 3 may lease such space for the Securities and Exchange
- 4 Commission under section 585 and this chapter.".
- 5 (b) Limitation on Statutory Construction.—
- 6 The amendment made by subsection (a) may not be con-
- 7 strued to invalidate or otherwise affect a lease entered into
- 8 by the Securities and Exchange Commission before the
- 9 date of enactment of this Act.
