A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to increase the preference given, in awarding certain allergies and asthma-related grants, to States that require certain public schools to have allergies and asthma management programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “School-Based Allergies*
 5 *and Asthma Management Program Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL PREFERENCE TO CERTAIN STATES**
 7 **THAT REQUIRE CERTAIN PUBLIC SCHOOLS**
 8 **TO HAVE ALLERGIES AND ASTHMA MANAGE-**
 9 **MENT PROGRAMS.**

10 *Section 399L(d) of the Public Health Service Act (42*
 11 *U.S.C. 280g(d)) is amended—*

12 *(1) in paragraph (1)(F)—*

13 *(A) by redesignating clauses (i), (ii), and*
 14 *(iii) as subclauses (I), (II), and (III), respec-*
 15 *tively, and moving each of such subclauses (as so*
 16 *redesignated) 2 ems to the right;*

17 *(B) by striking “EPINEPHRINE.—In deter-*
 18 *mining” and inserting “EPINEPHRINE OR*
 19 *SCHOOL COMPREHENSIVE ALLERGIES AND ASTH-*
 20 *MA MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.—*

21 *“(i) IN GENERAL.—In determining”;*

22 *(C) by striking “in the State—” and insert-*
 23 *ing “in the State satisfy the criteria described in*
 24 *clause (ii) or clause (iii).*

1 “(ii) *CRITERIA FOR SCHOOL PER-*
2 *SONNEL ADMINISTRATION OF EPINEPH-*
3 *RINE.—For purposes of clause (i), the cri-*
4 *teria described in this clause, with respect*
5 *to each public elementary school and sec-*
6 *ondary school in the State, are that each*
7 *such school—*”;
8 *and*

9 *(D) by adding at the end the following new*
10 *clause:*

11 “(iii) *CRITERIA FOR SCHOOL COM-*
12 *PREHENSIVE ALLERGIES AND ASTHMA MAN-*
13 *AGEMENT PROGRAM.—For purposes of*
14 *clause (i), the criteria described in this*
15 *clause, with respect to each public elemen-*
16 *tary school and secondary school in the*
17 *State, are that each such school—*

18 *“(I) has in place a plan for hav-*
19 *ing on the premises of the school dur-*
20 *ing all operating hours of the school a*
21 *school nurse or one or more other indi-*
22 *viduals who are designated by the*
23 *principal (or other appropriate admin-*
24 *istrative staff) of the school to direct*
 and apply the program described in

1 *subclause (II) on a voluntary basis*
2 *outside their scope of employment; and*

3 *“(II) has in place, under the di-*
4 *rection of a school nurse or other indi-*
5 *vidual designated under subclause (I),*
6 *a comprehensive school-based allergies*
7 *and asthma management program that*
8 *includes—*

9 *“(aa) a method to identify*
10 *all students of such school with a*
11 *diagnosis of allergies and asthma;*

12 *“(bb) an individual student*
13 *allergies and asthma action plan*
14 *for each student of such school*
15 *with a diagnosis of allergies and*
16 *asthma;*

17 *“(cc) allergies and asthma*
18 *education for school staff who are*
19 *directly responsible for students*
20 *who have been identified as hav-*
21 *ing allergies or asthma, such as*
22 *education regarding basics, man-*
23 *agement, trigger management,*
24 *and comprehensive emergency re-*

1 *sponses with respect to allergies*
2 *and asthma;*

3 *“(dd) efforts to reduce the*
4 *presence of environmental triggers*
5 *of allergies and asthma; and*

6 *“(ee) a system to support*
7 *students with a diagnosis of aller-*
8 *gies or asthma through coordina-*
9 *tion with family members of such*
10 *students, primary care providers*
11 *of such students, primary asthma*
12 *or allergy care providers of such*
13 *students, and others as nec-*
14 *essary.”; and*

15 *(2) in paragraph (3)(E)—*

16 *(A) in the matter preceding clause (i), by*
17 *inserting “, such as the school nurse” after “in-*
18 *dividual”; and*

19 *(B) in clause (i), by inserting “school nurse*
20 *or” before “principal”.*
