A BILL

To require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to provide training in the use of medical cannabis for all Department of Veterans Affairs primary care providers, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. TRAINING IN USE OF MEDICAL CANNABIS FOR**
4 **DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS PRI-**
5 **MARY CARE PROVIDERS.**

6 (a) TRAINING.—Not later than one year after the
7 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Vet-
8 erans Affairs shall provide for all primary care providers

1 of the Department of Veterans Affairs an initial training
2 in the use of medical cannabis. The Secretary shall provide
3 supplemental training as necessary.

4 (b) PARTNERSHIPS WITH MEDICAL SCHOOLS.—In
5 developing and providing the training to be provided under
6 subsection (a), the Secretary shall enter into partnerships
7 with medical schools that have incorporated education on
8 medical cannabis into their curricula.

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
