EFFECTS OF CERTAIN FEDERAL EMPLOYEES.

11 "(a) IN GENERAL.—Under regulations prescribed 12 under section 5738 and when the head of the agency con-13 cerned (or a designee thereof) authorizes or approves, if 14 a covered employee dies while performing official duties 15 or as a result of the performance of official duties, the 16 agency may pay from Government funds—

"(1) the qualified expenses of the immediate
family of the employee, if the place where the family
will reside following the death of the employee is—
"(A) different from the place where the
family resided at the time of the employee's
death; and

24 "(2) the expenses of preparing and transporting

7	"(b) QUALIFIED EXPENSES.—For purposes of this
8	section, the term 'qualified expenses', as used with respect
9	to a family changing its place of residence, means the mov-
10	ing expenses, transportation expenses, and relocation ex-
11	penses of the family which are attributable to the change
12	in place of residence.
13	"(c) Definitions.—For purposes of this section—
14	"(1) the term 'covered employee' means—
15	"(A) a law enforcement officer, as defined
16	by section 5541; and
17	"(B) any employee in or under the Federal
18	Bureau of Investigation who is not described in
19	subparagraph (A);
20	((2) the term 'moving expenses', as used with
21	respect to a family, includes the expenses of trans-
22	porting, packing, crating, temporarily storing,
23	draying, and unpacking the household goods and
24	personal effects of such family, not in excess of
25	18,000 pounds net weight; and

"(3) the term 'relocation expenses' has the
 meaning given such term under regulations pre scribed under section 5738, including relocation ex penses and relocation services described in sections
 5724a and 5724c, respectively.".
