- SEC. 2. RESCISSION OF STATE AND LOCAL IMMIGRATION
- 4 ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY.
- 5 Section 287(g) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 6 Act (8 U.S.C. 1357(g)) is amended to read as follows:
- 7 "(g) Except as provided in paragraph (10) of section
- 8 103(a), in section 274(c), and in section 439 of the
- 9 Antiterrorism and Effective Death Penalty Act of 1996
- 10 (8 U.S.C. 1252c), the authority to inquire about or verify
- 11 immigration or citizenship status and to investigate, ap-
- 12 prehend, arrest, or detain an individual for a violation of
- 13 this Act or any regulation authorized by this Act is re-
- 14 stricted to immigration officers and authorized employees
- 15 of the Department of Homeland Security and subject to
- 16 limits set forth in other provisions of law.".
