## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to require coverage without a deductible of certain primary care services by high deductible health plans.

#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Primary Care Patient

5 Protection Act of 2019".

# 6 SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT OF COVERAGE WITHOUT DEDUCT7 IBLE OF CERTAIN PRIMARY CARE SERVICES 8 BY HIGH DEDUCTIBLE HEALTH PLANS.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 223(c)(2)(B) of the Inter-

10 nal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking "if sub-

stantially all of its coverage is coverage described in para graph (1)(B)." and inserting the following: "if—

3 "(i) substantially all of its coverage is 4 coverage described in paragraph (1)(B), or 5 "(ii) such plan has a deductible for 6 primary care services provided by a quali-7 fied provider as part of a qualified visit.". 8 (b) QUALIFIED PRIMARY CARE SERVICES DE-FINED.—Section 223(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 9 1986 is amended by adding at the end the following new 10 11 paragraph:

"(6) PRIMARY CARE SERVICES.—The term 'primary care services' has the meaning given such term
by section 1833(x)(2)(B) of the Social Security Act,
without regard to clauses (ii) and (iii) of such section.

17 "(7) QUALIFIED PROVIDER.—The term 'quali18 fied provider' means a general practitioner, family
19 physician, general internist, obstetrician, gyne20 cologist, pediatrician, geriatric physician, or ad21 vanced practice registered nurse acting in accord22 ance with State laws.

23 "(8) QUALIFIED VISIT.—The term 'qualified
24 visit' means, with respect to an individual for a plan
25 year, either of the first 2 visits by the individual

during the year with a qualified provider who is des ignated by such individual as the primary care pro vider for such individual.".

4 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 this section shall apply to plan years beginning after the
6 date of the enactment of this Act.

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
