To prohibit the Secretary of Agriculture from restricting certain hunting activities in the Kisatchie National Forest, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. HUNTING IN THE KISATCHIE NATIONAL FOR-
- 4 **EST.**
- 5 Consistent with the Act of June 4, 1897 (16 U.S.C.
- 6 551), the Secretary may not restrict the use of dogs in
- 7 deer hunting activities in the Kisatchie National Forest,
- 8 unless such restrictions—
- 9 (1) apply to the smallest practicable portions of
- such forest; and

- 1 (2) are necessary to reduce or control trespass
- 2 onto land adjacent to such forest.
