4 This Act may be cited as "Teacher Tax Reduction5 Act of 2009".

1SEC. 2. INCREASE AND EXTENSION OF DEDUCTION FOR2CERTAIN EXPENSES OF ELEMENTARY AND3SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (D) of section

8 (1) by striking "\$250" and inserting "\$500",9 and

10 (2) by striking "during 2002" and all that fol11 lows through "2009" and inserting "after 2001 and

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
14 subsection (a) shall apply to taxable years beginning after
15 December 31, 2008.

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
