- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY FOR
- 4 MEMORIAL ESTABLISHMENT.
- 5 (a) Legislative Authority.—Section 1 of Public
- 6 Law 107–62 is amended by adding after subsection (e)
- 7 the following new subsection:

- 1 "(f) Expiration of Legislative Authority.—
- 2 Notwithstanding section 8903(e) of title 40, United States
- 3 Code, the legislative authority of the Adams Memorial
- 4 Foundation to establish a commemorative work on Fed-
- 5 eral land in the District of Columbia and its environs in
- 6 honor of former President John Adams and his family's
- 7 legacy shall expire on December 2, 2016.".
