## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to reauthorize the Supportive Services for Veteran Families Grant Program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Housing for Women
- 5 Veterans Act".

1	SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL AMOUNT FOR SUPPORTIVE SERVICES
2	FOR VETERAN FAMILIES GRANT PROGRAM
3	TO SUPPORT ORGANIZATIONS THAT HAVE A
4	FOCUS ON PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO
5	WOMEN VETERANS AND THEIR FAMILIES.
6	Section 2044(e) of title 38, United States Code, is
7	amended—
8	(1) in paragraph (1), by adding at the end the
9	following new subparagraph:
10	``(H) \$400,000,000 for each of fiscal years
11	2020 through 2022."; and
12	(2) by adding at the end the following new
13	paragraph:
14	(4) Not less than \$20,000,000 shall be avail-
15	able under paragraph (1)(H) for the provision of fi-
16	nancial assistance under subsection (a) to organiza-
17	tions that have a focus on providing assistance to
18	women veterans and their families.".
19	SEC. 3. GAP ANALYSIS OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-
20	FAIRS PROGRAMS THAT PROVIDE ASSIST-
21	ANCE TO WOMEN VETERANS WHO ARE HOME-
22	LESS.
23	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
24	shall complete an analysis of programs of the Department
25	of Veterans Affairs that provide assistance to women vet-
26	erans who are homeless or precariously housed to identify

- 1 the areas in which such programs are failing to meet the
- 2 needs of such women.
- 3 (b) Report.—Not later than 270 days after the date
- 4 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit
- 5 to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and
- 6 the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the House of Rep-
- 7 resentatives a report on the analysis completed under sub-
- 8 section (a).
