## A BILL

To amend chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, to clarify the circumstances under which the enhanced penalty provisions for subsequent convictions apply.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Firearm Recidivist  
5 Sentencing Act of 2009”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO ENHANCED PENALTIES PROVI-**  
7 **SIONS.**

8 Section 924(c) of title 18, United States Code, is  
9 amended—

1           (1) in paragraph (1)(C), by striking “In the  
2 case of a second or subsequent conviction under this  
3 subsection” and inserting “If a person is convicted  
4 under this subsection after a prior conviction under  
5 this subsection has become final”; and

6           (2) by adding at the end the following:

7           “(6) The provisions of section 411 of the Con-  
8 trolled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 851), other than  
9 subsections (a)(2) and (e) of such section, as in ef-  
10 fect on the date of the enactment of this paragraph,  
11 shall apply to sentencing for convictions under this  
12 subsection in the same manner in which such provi-  
13 sions apply to sentencing for offenses under part D  
14 of title II of such Act.”.
