## **AN ACT**

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to clarify presumptions relating to the exposure of certain veterans who served in the vicinity of the Republic of Vietnam, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Blue Water Navy Viet-3 nam Veterans Act of 2019".

# 4 SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF PRESUMPTIONS OF EXPOSURE 5 FOR VETERANS WHO SERVED IN VICINITY OF 6 REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 11 of title 38, United
8 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1116
9 the following new section:

10 "§1116A. Presumptions of service connection for vet-

## 11 erans who served offshore of the Repub-12 lic of Vietnam

"(a) SERVICE CONNECTION.—For the purposes of 13 section 1110 of this title, and subject to section 1113 of 14 this title, a disease covered by section 1116 of this title 15 16 becoming manifest as specified in that section in a veteran who, during active military, naval, or air service, served 17 18 offshore of the Republic of Vietnam during the period be-19 ginning on January 9, 1962, and ending on May 7, 1975, shall be considered to have been incurred in or aggravated 20 by such service, notwithstanding that there is no record 21 22 of evidence of such disease during the period of such serv-23 ice.

24 "(b) EXPOSURE.—A veteran who, during active mili25 tary, naval, or air service, served offshore of the Republic
26 of Vietnam during the period beginning on January 9,
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1 1962, and ending on May 7, 1975, shall be presumed to
2 have been exposed during such service to an herbicide
3 agent unless there is affirmative evidence to establish that
4 the veteran was not exposed to any such agent during that
5 service.

6 "(c) EFFECTIVE DATE OF AWARD.—(1) Except as
7 provided by paragraph (2), the effective date of an award
8 under this section shall be determined in accordance with
9 section 5110 of this title.

10 ((2)(A) Notwithstanding subsection (g) of section 5110 of this title, the Secretary shall determine the effec-11 tive date of an award based on a claim under this section 12 13 for an individual described in subparagraph (B) by treating the date on which the individual filed the prior claim 14 15 specified in clause (i) of such subparagraph as the date on which the individual filed the claim so awarded under 16 17 this section.

18 "(B) An individual described in this subparagraph is
19 a veteran, or a survivor of a veteran, who meets the fol20 lowing criteria:

"(i) The veteran or survivor submitted a claim
for disability compensation on or after September
25, 1985, and before January 1, 2020, for a disease
covered by this section, and the claim was denied by
reason of the claim not establishing that the disease

was incurred or aggravated by the service of the vet eran.

"(ii) The veteran or survivor submits a claim
for disability compensation on or after January 1,
2020, for the same condition covered by the prior
claim under clause (i), and the claim is approved
pursuant to this section.

8 "(d) DETERMINATION OF OFFSHORE.—Notwith-9 standing any other provision of law, for purposes of this 10 section, the Secretary shall treat a location as being off-11 shore of Vietnam if the location is not more than 12 nau-12 tical miles seaward of a line commencing on the south-13 western demarcation line of the waters of Vietnam and 14 Cambodia and intersecting the following points:

4	(d) OUTREACH.—
5	(1) REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary of Veterans
6	Affairs shall conduct outreach to inform veterans de-
7	scribed in paragraph (2) of the ability to submit a
8	claim for disability compensation under section
9	1116A of title 38, United States Code, as added by
10	subsection (a). Such outreach shall include the fol-
11	lowing:
12	(A) The Secretary shall publish on the
13	website of the Department a notice that a vet-
14	erans described in paragraph (2) may submit or
15	resubmit a claim for disability compensation
16	under such section 1116A.
17	(B) The Secretary shall notify in writing
18	the veteran service organization community of
19	the ability of veterans described in paragraph
20	(2) to submit or resubmit claims for disability
21	compensation under such section 1116A.
22	(2) VETERAN DESCRIBED.—A veteran described
23	in this paragraph is a veteran who, during active
24	military, naval, or air service, served offshore of the

Republic of Vietnam during the period beginning on
 January 9, 1962, and ending on May 7, 1975.

3 (e) REPORTS.—Not later than January 1, 2021, and 4 annually thereafter for 2 years, the Secretary of Veterans 5 Affairs shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the House of Representatives and the Senate a 6 7 report regarding claims for disability compensation under 8 section 1116A of title 38, United States Code, as added 9 by subsection (a). Each report shall include, with respect 10 to the calendar year preceding the report, disaggregated by the regional offices of the Department of Veterans Af-11 fairs, the following: 12

13 (1) The number of claims filed under such sec-14 tion.

15 (2) The number of such claims granted.

16 (3) The number of such claims denied.

(f) HEALTH CARE.—Section 1710(e)(4) of title 38,

of Vietnam".

(g) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made bythis section shall take effect on January 1, 2020.

"(a) Presumption of Service-Connection.—(1) 8 9 For the purposes of section 1110 of this title, and subject to section 1113 of this title, a disease specified in sub-10 11 section (b) that becomes manifest as specified in that sub-12 section in a veteran described in paragraph (2) shall be 13 considered to have been incurred or aggravated in the line of duty in the active military, naval, or air service, not-14 15 withstanding that there is no record of evidence of such 16 disease during the period of such service.

"(2) A veteran described in this paragraph is a veteran who, during active military, naval, or air service,
served in or near the Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ),
during the period beginning on September 1, 1967, and
ending on August 31, 1971.

22 "(b) DISEASES.—A disease specified in this sub-23 section is—

24 "(1) a disease specified in paragraph (2) of
25 subsection (a) of section 1116 of this title that be26 comes manifest as specified in that paragraph; or

BENEFITS FOR CHILDREN OF CERTAIN THAILAND 10 SERVICE VETERANS BORN WITH **SPINA** 11 **BIFIDA.** 12 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter III of chapter 18 of 13 title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new section: 14 "§1822. Benefits for children of certain Thailand 15 16 service veterans born with spina bifida 17 "(a) BENEFITS AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary may provide to any child of a veteran of covered service in 18 19 Thailand who is suffering from spina bifida the health 20 care, vocational training and rehabilitation, and monetary 21 allowance required to be paid to a child of a Vietnam vet-

22 eran who is suffering from spina bifida under subchapter
23 I of this chapter as if such child of a veteran of covered
24 service in Thailand were a child of a Vietnam veteran who
25 is suffering from spina bifida under such subchapter.

"(b) SPINA BIFIDA CONDITIONS COVERED.—This
 section applies with respect to all forms and manifesta tions of spina bifida, except spina bifida occulta.

4 "(c) VETERAN OF COVERED SERVICE IN THAI5 LAND.—For purposes of this section, a veteran of covered
6 service in Thailand is any individual, without regard to
7 the characterization of that individual's service, who—

8 "(1) served in the active military, naval, or air 9 service in Thailand, as determined by the Secretary 10 in consultation with the Secretary of Defense, dur-11 ing the period beginning on January 9, 1962, and 12 ending on May 7, 1975; and

"(2) is determined by the Secretary, in consultation with the Secretary of Defense, to have been
exposed to a herbicide agent during such service in
Thailand.

"(d) HERBICIDE AGENT.—For purposes of this section, the term 'herbicide agent' means a chemical in a herbicide used in support of United States and allied military
operations in Thailand, as determined by the Secretary in
consultation with the Secretary of Defense, during the period beginning on January 9, 1962, and ending on May
7, 1975.".

# AN ACT

To amend title 38, United States Code, to elarify presumptions relating to the exposure of certain veterans who served in the vicinity of the Republic of Vietnam, and for other purposes.
