A BILL

To amend the Missing Children’s Assistance Act to better enable law enforcement to identify, locate, and recover child victims of sex trafficking.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO THE MISSING CHILDREN’S AS-**
4 **SISTANCE ACT.**

5 Section 404(b)(1) of the Missing Children’s Assist-
6 ance Act (42 U.S.C. 5773(b)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (R) by striking at the end
8 “and”;

9 (2) in subparagraph (S) by striking the period
10 at the end and inserting “; and”; and

1 (3) by adding at the end the following:

2 “(T) provide technical assistance to law
3 enforcement agencies and first responders in
4 identifying, locating, and recovering victims of
5 child sex trafficking.”.

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
