1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Safe Sleep for Babies3 Act of 2019".

4 SEC. 2. BANNING OF INCLINED SLEEPERS FOR INFANTS.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
6 date of enactment of this Act, inclined sleepers for infants,
7 regardless of the date of manufacture, shall be considered
8 a banned hazardous product under section 8 of the Con9 sumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2057).

10 (b) INCLINED SLEEPER FOR INFANTS DEFINED.— 11 In this section, the term "inclined sleeper for infants" 12 means a product with an inclined sleep surface greater 13 than ten degrees that is intended, marketed, or designed 14 to provide sleeping accommodations for an infant up to 15 1 year old.

16 SEC. 3. BANNING OF CRIB BUMPERS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
date of enactment of this Act, crib bumpers, regardless
of the date of manufacture, shall be considered a banned
hazardous product under section 8 of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2057).

(b) CRIB BUMPER DEFINED.—In this section, theterm "crib bumper"—

(1) means any material that is intended to
cover the sides of a crib to prevent injury to any crib
occupant from impacts against the side of a crib or

to prevent partial or complete access to any openings
 in the sides of a crib to prevent a crib occupant from
 getting any part of the body entrapped in any open ing;

5 (2) includes a padded crib bumper, a supported
6 and unsupported vinyl bumper guard, and vertical
7 crib slat covers; and

8 (3) does not include a non-padded mesh crib9 liner.
