- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

 SECTION 1. MACHINE READABILITY AND ELECTRONIC

 TRANSFERABILITY OF CERTIFICATE OF RELEASE OR DISCHARGE FROM ACTIVE DUTY

 (DD FORM 214).

 (a) MODIFICATION REQUIRED.—The Secretary of
