A BILL

To limit the availability of certain funds for Mexico until the President makes a certification to Congress regarding cooperation by Mexico with respect to fentanyl, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS**
4 **UNDER ECONOMIC SUPPORT FUND FOR MEX-**
5 **ICO.**

6 (a) LIMITATION.—No amounts made available under
7 chapter 4 of part II of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961
8 (22 U.S.C. 2346 et seq.) (relating to the economic support

1 fund) for assistance for Mexico that are unobligated as
2 of the date of the enactment of this Act may be obligated
3 or expended until the President submits to Congress a
4 written certification that Mexico is cooperating with the
5 United States to reduce the flow of fentanyl across the
6 southern border of the United States.

7 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in sub-
8 section (a) shall be construed as limiting the obligation
9 or expenditure of funds made available for assistance to
10 Mexico for international narcotics control under chapter
11 8 of part I of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22
12 U.S.C. 2291 et seq.) or for immigration enforcement pur-
13 poses.
