1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defund the OTF Act
5 of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON AVAILABILITY OF FEDERAL**
7 **FUNDS FOR OPEN TECHNOLOGY FUND.**

8 No Federal funds may be made available for the
9 Open Technology Fund established under section 309A of

- 2 (22 U.S.C. 6208a).
