1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO AGREE TO AN AMENDMENT TO**
2 **THE BORDER ENVIRONMENT COOPERATION**
3 **AGREEMENT.**

4 Section 545 of the North American Free Trade
5 Agreement Implementation Act (22 U.S.C. 290m-4) is
6 amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “; and” and in-
8 serting a semicolon;

9 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking the period and
10 inserting “; and”; and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(3) expand the purposes and functions of the
13 Border Environment Cooperation Commission and
14 the North American Development Bank to allow the
15 Commission to certify, and the Bank to finance, any
16 infrastructure in the border region.”.
