A BILL

To provide that Executive Order 14096 shall have no force or effect.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Preventing Executive
5 Climate Overreach Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXECUTIVE ORDER 14096.**

2 Executive Order 14096 (88 Fed. Reg. 25251; relat-
3 ing to revitalizing our Nation's commitment to environ-
4 mental justice for all) shall have no force or effect.
