A BILL

To amend the definition of commercial motor vehicle in section 31101 of title 49, United States Code, to exclude certain farm vehicles, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE.

Section 31101(1)(A) of title 49, United States Code,

is amended to read as follows:

"(A)(i) except as provided in clause (ii),
