A BILL

To direct the Attorney General to create a special reward program for individuals providing information leading to the apprehension and conviction of persons committing offenses under section 1030 of title 18, United States Code, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Providing Rewards for
5 Outstanding Tips to Expose Crimes in Technology Act of
6 2015” or “PROTECT Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. CYBERCRIME REWARD PROGRAM.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General shall estab-
3 lish and publicize a special reward program for individuals
4 providing information leading to the apprehension and
5 conviction of persons committing offenses under section
6 1030 of title 18, United States Code.

7 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
8 are authorized to be appropriated \$1,000,000 for each of
9 fiscal years 2016 through 2020 to carry out this section.

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
