A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to revise the Final
List of Critical Minerals, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Uranium Classification*
5 *Act of 2019”.*

6 **SEC. 2. REVISION OF FINAL RULE REGARDING CRITICAL**
7 **MINERALS.**

8 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*Not later than 60 days after the*
9 *date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior*
10 *shall revise the Final List of Critical Minerals, and any*
11 *related regulations, to remove uranium from such list.*

12 (b) *RESTRICTION.*—*The Secretary of the Interior may*
13 *not add uranium to the Final List of Critical Minerals.*

14 (c) *FINAL LIST OF CRITICAL MINERALS.*—*The term*
15 *“Final List of Critical Minerals” means the Final List of*
16 *Critical Minerals issued pursuant to Executive Order 13817*
17 *(82 Fed. Reg. 60835, relating to a Federal strategy to en-*
18 *sure secure and reliable supplies of critical minerals).*

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
