Mr. CARSON (for himself and Ms. TLAIB) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To require a report on the death of Shireen Abu Akleh.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORT ON DEATH OF SHIREEN ABU AKLEH.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the
5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the Fed-
6 eral Bureau of Investigation and Secretary of State, in
7 consultation with the Attorney General, Director of Na-
8 tional Intelligence, and Secretary of Defense, shall submit
9 to Congress a report on the death of Shireen Abu Akleh.

10 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report re-
11 quired by subsection (a) shall include—

1 (1) an identification of those individuals and
2 entities that carried out, participated in, or were
3 otherwise complicit in, or responsible for the death
4 of Shireen Abu Akleh;

5 (2) an identification of any United States de-
6 fense materials, funds or services that were impli-
7 cated in the death of Shireen Abu Akleh; and

8 (3) as attachments, any unredacted report that
9 may be relevant, including any report conducted by
10 the U.S. Security Coordinator for Israel and the
11 Palestinian Authority.

12 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
13 shall be submitted in unclassified form and made available
14 to the public at the same time on the website of the De-
15 partment of State.
