Mr. VAN DREW introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Appropriations

A BILL

Making continuing appropriations for the Coast Guard.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pay Our Coast Guard
5 Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF**

7 **THE COAST GUARD.**

8 There are hereby appropriated for fiscal year 2019,
9 out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appro-
10 priated, for any period during which interim or full-year
11 appropriations for the Coast Guard are not in effect—

1 (1) such sums as are necessary to provide pay
2 and allowances to members of the Coast Guard (as
3 described in section 1 of title 14, United States
4 Code), including the reserve component thereof, who
5 perform active service or inactive-duty training dur-
6 ing such period;

7 (2) such sums as are necessary to provide pay
8 and allowances to civilian employees of the Coast
9 Guard;

10 (3) such sums as are necessary to provide pay
11 and allowances to contractors of the Coast Guard;
12 and

13 (4) such sums as are necessary for—

14 (A) the payment of a death gratuity under
15 sections 1475 through 1477 and 1489 of title
16 10, United States Code, with respect to mem-
17 bers of the Coast Guard;

18 (B) the payment or reimbursement of au-
19 thorized funeral travel and travel related to the
20 dignified transfer of remains and unit memorial
21 services under section 481f of title 37, United
22 States Code, with respect to members of the
23 Coast Guard; and

24 (C) the temporary continuation of a basic
25 allowance of housing for dependents of mem-

1 bers of the Coast Guard dying on active duty,
2 as authorized by section 403(l) of title 37,
3 United States Code.

4 **SEC. 3. TERMINATION.**

5 Appropriations and funds made available and author-
6 ity granted pursuant to this Act shall be available until
7 whichever of the following first occurs:

8 (1) The enactment into law of an appropriation
9 (including a continuing appropriation) for any pur-
10 pose for which amounts are made available in sec-
11 tion 2.

12 (2) The enactment into law of the applicable
13 regular or continuing appropriations resolution or
14 other Act without any appropriation for such pur-
15 pose.

16 (3) September 30, 2019.
