5	(a) ENROLLMENT.—Section 1705(a) of title 38,

8	(A) by striking "and veterans" and insert-
9	ing ", veterans"; and
10	(B) by striking the period at the end and
11	inserting ", and veterans who are former pris-
12	oners of war."; and
13	(2) in paragraph (3), by striking "who are
14	former prisoners of war or".
15	(b) EXTENDED CARE SERVICES.—Section
16	$1710 \mathrm{B}(\mathrm{c})(2)(\mathrm{D})$ of such title is amended by inserting ''a
17	veteran who is a former prisoner of war or" before "a vet-
18	eran who''.
19	(c) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by this
20	section shall apply with respect to veterans who are former
21	prisoners of war before, on, or after the date of the enact-
22	ment of this Act.
