A BILL

To require the Administrator of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration to study the feasibility of constructing an aramid synthetic fiber aqueduct to transport water from Oregon to California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STUDY.**

4 The Administrator of the National Aeronautics and
5 Space Administration shall conduct a study of the feasi-
6 bility of constructing an aqueduct using aramid synthetic
7 fiber for the purpose of transporting water from Oregon
8 to California.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORT TO CONGRESS.**

2 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
3 of this Act, the Administrator shall submit to Congress
4 a report describing the results of the study required under
5 section 1.

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
