- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Northern Border Com-
- 5 merce Protection Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REINSTATEMENT OF CERTAIN NAFTA CUSTOMS
- 7 FEES EXEMPTION.
- 8 (a) In General.—Section 13031(b)(1)(A)(i) of the
- 9 Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985
- 10 (19 U.S.C. 58c(b)(1)(A)(i)) is amended—

1	(1) in subclause (I), by striking "or" at the
2	end;
3	(2) in subclause (II), by adding "or" at the
4	end; and
5	(3) by adding at the end the following:
6	"(III) originated in Canada or origi-
7	nated in the United States or a territory or
8	possession of the United States and was
9	limited to Canada;".
10	(b) Use of Fees.—The fees collected as a result of
11	the amendment made by this section shall be deposited
12	in the Customs User Fee Account, shall be available for
13	reimbursement of customs services and inspections costs,
14	and shall be available only to the extent provided in appro-
15	priations Acts.
16	(c) Effective Date.—This section and the amend-
17	ments made by this section shall take effect on the date
18	of the enactment of this Act and apply to passengers arriv-
