(2) by adding at the end the following: ", ex-12 13 cept that in the case of an individual pursuing a pro-14 gram of education offered through distance learning, 15 the amount of the monthly housing stipend under 16 this clause shall be the amount equal to the monthly 17 amount of the basic allowance for housing payable 18 under section 403 of title 37 for a member with de-19 pendents in pay grade E–5 residing in the military 20 housing area that encompasses all or the majority portion of the ZIP code area in which the individual 21 22 resides.".
