#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Economic
- 5 Opportunity Administration Act of 2009".

# SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF VETERANS ECONOMIC OPPOR TUNITY ADMINISTRATION OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS. (a) ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY ADMINISTRATION.—

5 Part V of title 38, United States Code, is amended by

6 adding at the end the following new chapter:

## 7 "CHAPTER 80—VETERANS ECONOMIC 8 OPPORTUNITY ADMINISTRATION

"8001. Organization of Administration.

"8002. Functions of Administration.

"8003. Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization.

### 9 "§ 8001. Organization of Administration

10 "(a) Veterans Economic Opportunity Adminis-11 TRATION.—There is in the Department of Veterans Af-12 fairs a Veterans Economic Opportunity Administration. 13 The primary function of the Veterans Economic Oppor-14 tunity Administration is the administration of the pro-15 grams of the Department which provide assistance related 16 to economic opportunity to veterans and their dependents and survivors. 17

18 "(b) UNDER SECRETARY FOR ECONOMIC OPPOR19 TUNITY.—The Veterans Economic Opportunity Adminis20 tration is under the Under Secretary for Veterans Eco21 nomic Opportunity, who is directly responsible to the Sec22 retary for the operations of the Administration.

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"§ 8002. Functions of Administration

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### 2 "The Veterans Economic Opportunity Administra-3 tion is responsible for the administration of the following programs of the Department: 4 5 "(1) Vocational rehabilitation and employment 6 programs. 7 "(2) Educational assistance programs. 8 "(3) Veterans' housing loan and related pro-9 grams. "(4) Veterans entrepreneurship programs. 10 "(5) Programs for homeless veterans. 11 12 "§ 8003. Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business 13 Utilization 14 "Notwithstanding section 15(k) of the Small Busi-15 ness Act (15 U.S.C. 644(k)), the head of the Office of 16 Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization shall report directly to both the Secretary and the Under Secretary 17 for Veterans Economic Opportunity.". 18 19 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.—The tables of chapters at the beginning of title 38, and of part V of title 20 21 38, are each amended by inserting after the item relating to chapter 79 the following new item: 22 "80. Veterans Economic Opportunity Administration ....... 8001".

3 (a) UNDER SECRETARY.—Chapter 3 of title 38,
4 United States Code, is amended by inserting after section
5 306 the following new section:

## 6 "§ 306A. Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Op7 portunity

8 "(a) UNDER SECRETARY.—There is in the Depart-9 ment an Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Oppor-10 tunity, who is appointed by the President, by and with 11 the advice and consent of the Senate. The Under Sec-12 retary for Veterans Economic Opportunity shall be ap-13 pointed without regard to political affiliation or activity 14 and solely on the basis of demonstrated ability in—

15 "(1) fiscal management; and

"(2) the administration of programs within the
Veterans Economic Opportunity Administration or
programs of similar content and scope.

"(b) RESPONSIBILITIES.—The Under Secretary for
Veterans Economic Opportunity is the head of, and is directly responsible to the Secretary for the operations of,
the Veterans Economic Opportunity Administration.

23 "(c) VACANCIES.—(1) Whenever a vacancy in the po24 sition of Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Oppor25 tunity occurs or is anticipated, the Secretary shall estab-

lish a commission to recommend individuals to the Presi dent for appointment to the position.

3 "(2) A commission established under this subsection
4 shall be composed of the following members appointed by
5 the Secretary:

6 "(A) Three persons representing education and
7 training, vocational rehabilitation, employment, real
8 estate, mortgage finance and related industries, and
9 survivor benefits activities affected by the Veterans
10 Economic Opportunity Administration.

11 "(B) Two persons representing veterans served
12 by the Veterans Economic Opportunity Administra13 tion.

14 "(C) Two persons who have experience in the
15 management of veterans benefits programs or pro16 grams of similar content and scope.

17 "(D) The Deputy Secretary of Veterans Affairs.
18 "(E) The chairman of the Veterans' Advisory
19 Committee on Education formed under section 3692
20 of this title.

"(F) One person who has held the position of
Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Opportunity, if the Secretary determines that it is desirable for such person to be a member of the commission.

1 "(3) A commission established under this subsection 2 shall recommend at least three individuals for appoint-3 ment to the position of Under Secretary for Veterans Eco-4 nomic Opportunity. The commission shall submit all rec-5 ommendations to the Secretary. The Secretary shall for-6 ward the recommendations to the President with any com-7 ments the Secretary considers appropriate. Thereafter, the 8 President may request the commission to recommend ad-9 ditional individuals for appointment.

"(4) The Assistant Secretary or Deputy Assistant
Secretary of Veterans Affairs who performs personnel
management and labor relations functions shall serve as
the executive secretary of a commission established under
this subsection.

15 "(d) QUALIFICATIONS OF RECOMMENDED INDIVID-16 UALS.—Each individual recommended to the President by 17 the commission for appointment to the position of Under 18 Secretary for Veterans Economic Opportunity shall be an 19 individual who has held a senior level position in the pri-20 vate sector with responsibilities relating to at least one of 21 the following:

- 22 "(1) Education policy.
- 23 "(2) Vocational rehabilitation.
- 24 "(3) Employment.
- 25 "(4) Home loan finance.

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"(5) Small business development.". 1 2 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections 3 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting 4 after the item relating to section 306 the following new 5 item: "306A. 5 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Chapter 3 of title 38, United
6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol7 lowing new section:

8 "§ 323. Department of Veterans Affairs-Department of

9 Labor-Small Business Administration
 10 Joint Executive Committee on Economic
 11 Opportunity

"(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—(1) There is established an
interagency committee to be known as the Department of
Veterans Affairs-Department of Labor-Small Business
Administration Joint Executive Committee on Economic
Opportunity (hereinafter in this section referred to as the
"Committee").

18 "(2) The Committee is composed of—

19 "(A) the Under Secretary of Veterans Affairs20 for Veterans Economic Opportunity;

21 "(B) the Director of Homeless Programs of the22 Department of Veterans Affairs;

23 "(C) the Assistant Secretary of Labor for Vet-24 erans Employment and Training; and

"(D) the Associate Administrator of the Small
 Business Administration for Veterans Business De velopment.

4 "(b) ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS.—(1) The Deputy 5 Secretary of Veterans Affairs, the Under Secretary of 6 Labor, and the Administrator of the Small Business Ad-7 ministration shall jointly determine the administrative and 8 procedural guidelines for the operation of the Committee.

9 "(2) The two Departments and the Small Business
10 Administration shall supply appropriate staff and re11 sources to provide administrative support and services.
12 Support for such purposes shall be provided at a level suf13 ficient for the efficient operation of the Committee.

"(c) RECOMMENDATIONS.—(1) The Committee shall 14 15 recommend to the Secretaries and the Administrator strategic direction for the joint coordination and sharing ef-16 forts between and within the two Departments and the 17 18 Administration to promote and administer veterans economic opportunity programs for education and training, 19 vocational rehabilitation, employment, small business, and 20 21 homelessness under section 8111 of this title, and shall 22 oversee implementation of those efforts.

23 "(2) The Committee shall submit to the two Secre-24 taries and the Administrator and directly to Congress an

annual report containing such recommendations as the
 Committee considers appropriate.

3 "(d) FUNCTIONS.—In order to enable the Committee
4 to make recommendations in its annual report under sub5 section (c)(2), the Committee shall do the following:

6 "(1) Review existing policies, procedures, and
7 practices relating to the coordination and sharing of
8 resources between the two Departments.

9 "(2) Identify changes in policies, procedures, 10 and practices that, in the judgment of the Com-11 mittee, would promote mutually beneficial coordina-12 tion, use, or exchange of use of services and re-13 sources of the two Departments and the Administra-14 tion, with the goal of improving the quality, effi-15 ciency and effectiveness of the delivery of benefits 16 and services to veterans, service members, military 17 retirees, and their families through a relationship 18 among the Department of Veterans Affairs, the De-19 partment of Labor, and the Small Business Admin-20 istration.

21 "(3) Identify and assess further opportunities 22 for the coordination and collaboration between the 23 Departments and the Administration that, in the 24 judgment of the Committee, would not adversely af-25 fect the range of services, the quality of care, or the

2	of the Departments or the Administration.	
3	"(4) Review the plans of both Departments and	
4	the Administration for the acquisition of additional	
5	resources, especially new facilities and major equip-	
6	ment and technology, in order to assess the potential	
7	effect of such plans on further opportunities for the	
8	coordination and sharing of resources.	
9	"(5) Review the implementation of activities de-	
10	signed to promote the coordination and sharing of	
11	resources between the Departments and the Admin-	
12	istration.	
13	"(e) Consultation With Certain Organiza-	
14	TIONS.—In carrying out its responsibilities under this sec-	
15	tion, the Committee may consult with appropriate organi-	
16	zations that promote employment.".	
17	(b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections	
18	at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding	
19	at the end the following new item:
