Mr. SOTO introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to provide housing for students enrolled in an accredited avionic program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Avionic Students
5 Housing Act.”

6 **SEC. 2. AVIONIC STUDENT HOUSING.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 401 of title 49, United
8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
9 lowing:

1 **“§ 40131. Avionic student housing at airports**

2 “(a) HOUSING.—An airport, airport authority, air-
3 port sponsor, school or other airport operator may provide
4 housing for students enrolled in an accredited avionic pro-
5 gram, on the non-aeronautical area grounds of an airport.
6 Such housing may be for a term of 12 months, renewable
7 to a total duration of the lesser of—

8 “(1) 36 months; or

9 “(2) completion of the avionic program.

10 “(b) AVIONIC PROGRAM DEFINED.—In this section,
11 the term ‘avionic program’ means a program leading to
12 a degree, certification or qualifications for a career as a
13 pilot, mechanic, air traffic controller, airline support per-
14 sonnel, or other avionics-related field.”.

15 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis for chap-
16 ter 401 of title 49, United States Code, is amended by
17 adding at the end the following:

“40131. Avionic student housing at airports.”.
