- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Small Business SOX
- 5 Compliance Relief Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF MORATORIUM.
- 7 Not later than 30 days after the date of enactment
- 8 of this Act, the Securities and Exchange Commission shall
- 9 modify its regulations under section 404 of the Sarbanes-
- 10 Oxley Act of 2002 (15 U.S.C. 7262) to exempt non-accel-

- 1 erated filers (as defined in such regulations on the date
- 2 of enactment of this Act) from the requirements of sub-

3 section (b) of such section.
