1 **SECTION 1. HELEN FABELA CHÁVEZ MEMORIAL POST OF-**
2 **FICE BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located 401 Main Street in Brawley, Cali-
5 fornia, shall be known and designated as the “Helen
6 Fabela Chávez Memorial Post Office Building”.

7 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
8 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
9 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
10 be deemed to be a reference to the “Helen Fabela Chávez
11 Memorial Post Office Building”.

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
