A BILL

To amend the Education Sciences and Reform Act of 2002 to include racial subgroups in IPEDS data, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Student Data Counts
5 Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF RACIAL SUBGROUPS IN IPEDS DATA.**

7 Section 153(a)(3) of the Education Sciences Reform
8 Act of 2002 (20 U.S.C. 9543(a)(3)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “feasible, information” and in-
2 serting the following: “feasible—

3 “(A) information”;

4 (2) by inserting “and” after the semicolon; and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(B) information from the Integrated
7 Postsecondary Education Data Survey or a suc-
8 cessor system (whichever includes the most re-
9 cent data), that is disaggregated by race in a
10 manner that captures all the racial groups spec-
11 ified in the American Community Survey of the
12 United States Census Bureau;”.
