3 SECTION 1. KA'U COAST STUDY; REPORT.

- 4 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This section may be cited as the
- 5 "Ka'u Coast Preservation Act".
- 6 (b) Study.—
- 7 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Inte8 rior shall complete a study to determine the suit9 ability and feasibility of designating the Ka'u Coast

on the island of Hawaii, as a unit of the National
Park System.
(2) Study area.—The study area shall extend
generally from Kapaoo Point to Kahuku Point, Ha-
waii.
(3) Applicability of other law.—Para-
graphs (2) and (3) of section 8(c) of Public Law 91–
383 (16 U.S.C. $1a-5(c)(2)$ and (3); commonly
known as the National Park System General Au-
thorities Act) shall apply to the study.
(c) REPORT.—Upon completion of the study required
by subsection (b), the Secretary of the Interior shall trans-
mit to the Committee on Natural Resources of the House
of Representatives and the Committee on Energy and
Natural Resources of the Senate a report containing the
conclusions of the study.
