3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Care Packages for Our

5 Heroes Act of 2019".

1SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF RATES OF POSTAGE FOR2PACKAGES SHIPPED BY PRIORITY MAIL3FROM THE UNITED STATES TO A FOREIGN4ARMY POST OFFICE, FLEET POST OFFICE, OR5DIPLOMATIC POST OFFICE.

6 Section 3633 of title 39 of the United States Code7 is amended by adding at the end the following:

8 "(c) EXEMPTION.—Notwithstanding subsection (a), 9 not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this subsection, the Postal Regulatory Commission shall 10 promulgate regulations to establish rates of postage for 11 packages shipped by priority mail from the United States 12 to a foreign Army Post Office, Fleet Post Office, or Diplo-13 14 matic Post Office address whereby a person may not be charged for such packages traveling through a zone other 15 than a first zone or a second zone (as defined in section 16 17 4040 of title 39, Code of Federal Regulations, respec-18 tively).".
