1	SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR INFORMATION ABOUT BUY
2	AMERICAN LAW AND ACCEPTABLE FOREIGN
3	GOODS TO BE INCLUDED IN CERTAIN FED-
4	ERAL CONTRACT SOLICITATIONS.
5	(a) REQUIREMENT.—In any solicitation for a Federal
6	contract for the procurement of goods, the Federal agency
7	issuing the solicitation shall include the following informa-
8	tion:
9	(1) A statement of—
10	(A) whether chapter 83 of title 41, United

11 States Code (popularly known as the "Buy 12 American Act"), applies or does not apply to 13 the contract; and

(B) if such chapter 83 does not apply to
the contract, the reasons why such chapter does
not apply, including a description of any applicable exception or waiver of such chapter and
the law or regulation providing such exception
or waiver.

20 (2) Whether such chapter 83 applies or does
21 not apply—

(A) a statement of whether goods from foreign countries would be acceptable as end products for purposes of fulfilling the requirements
of the contract; and

(B) a list of all the foreign countries whose
 goods would be acceptable as end products for
 such purposes.

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This Act shall apply to so5 licitations for contracts issued after the date occurring
6 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
