- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 6 sion of law, no person may be sentenced to death or put
- 7 to death on or after the date of enactment of this Act
- 8 for any violation of Federal law.

- 1 (b) Persons Sentenced Before Date of Enact-
- 2 MENT.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any
- 3 person sentenced to death before the date of enactment
- 4 of this Act for any violation of Federal law shall be resen-
