

1 **“§ 11. Flags displayed on Federal buildings or**
2 **grounds.**

3 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Only specified flags may be dis-
4 played on Federal buildings or grounds.

5 “(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6 “(1) SPECIFIED FLAG.—The term ‘specified
7 flag’ means any of the following:

8 “(A) The flag of the United States.

9 “(B) The flag of a State.

10 “(C) The flag of an Indian Tribal govern-
11 ment.

12 “(D) A flag of the Armed Forces of the
13 United States.

14 “(E) The National League of Families
15 POW/MIA flag.

16 “(2) STATE.—The term ‘State’ means each
17 State, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the
18 Virgin Islands, Guam, American Samoa, and the
19 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

20 “(3) INDIAN TRIBAL GOVERNMENT.—The term
21 ‘Indian Tribal government’ means the governing
22 body of any Indian or Alaska Native tribe, band, na-
23 tion, pueblo, village, or community that the Sec-
24 retary of the Interior acknowledges to exist as an In-
25 dian tribe under the Federally Recognized Indian
26 Tribe List Act of 1994 (25 U.S.C. 479a et seq.).

1 “(c) **MILITARY HOUSING.**—Subsection (a) shall not
2 apply to military housing.”.

3 (b) **CLERICAL AMENDMENT.**—The analysis for chap-
4 ter 1 of title 4, United States Code, is amended by adding
5 at the end the following new item:

“11. Flags displayed on Federal buildings or grounds.”.
