- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Brucella Abortus Re-
- 5 moval Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF BRUCELLA ABORTUS FROM LISTS.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on the date of the en-
- 8 actment of this Act, the lists of biological agents and tox-
- 9 ins established and maintained under section 351A(a)(1)

- 1 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 262a(a)(1))
- 2 and section 212(a)(1) of the Agricultural Bioterrorism
- 3 Protection Act of 2002 (7 U.S.C. 8401 note) shall not in-
- 4 clude brucella abortus.
- 5 (b) Conforming Changes.—The Secretary of
- 6 Health and Human Services and the Secretary of Agri-
- 7 culture shall revise the regulations, guidance, and other
- 8 materials of the Department of Health and Human Serv-
- 9 ices and the Department of Agriculture, respectively, to
- 10 the extent necessary for consistency with subsection (a).
