1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. FIVE-YEAR RECOVER PERIOD FOR COMPUTER 4 BASED GAMBLING MACHINES.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section
6 168(e)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amend7 ed by striking "and" at the end of clause (vi)(III), by
8 striking the period at the end of clause (vii) and inserting
9 ", and", and by adding at the end the following new
10 clause:

"(viii) any computer-based gambling
 machine, including slot machines and video
 lottery terminals.".

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
5 this section shall apply to property placed in service after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
