## A BILL

To extend the suspension of duty on staple fibers of rayon, carded, combed, or otherwise processed for spinning.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STAPLE FIBERS OF RAYON, CARDED, COMBED,**

4 **OR OTHERWISE PROCESSED FOR SPINNING.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.34 of the Har-  
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
7 staple fibers of rayon, carded, combed, or otherwise proc-  
8 essed for spinning) is amended by striking the date in the  
9 effective period column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 this section applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
