H. R. 504

To amend title 5, United States Code, to require an executive agency to submit information to any committee of the House of Representatives upon the request of 7 of the members of the committee, and to submit information to any committee of the Senate upon the request of 5 of the members of the committee, if the information relates to any matter under the jurisdiction of the committee, and for other purposes.

Mr. BURGESS (for himself and Mr. DAVIS of Illinois) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Accountability

A BILL

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1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Response from Execu-
3 tive Agencies to Congress on Time Act” or the “REACT
4 Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. REQUIRING SUBMISSION OF INFORMATION TO**
6 **COMMITTEES UPON REQUEST OF MINIMUM**
7 **NUMBER OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS.**

8 (a) SUBMISSION OF INFORMATION.—Section 2954 of
9 title 5, United States Code, is amended by striking “agen-
10 cy, on request” and all that follows through “shall submit”
11 and inserting the following: “agency, on request of any
12 authorizing committee or permanent select committee of
13 the House of Representatives or of any 7 members thereof,
14 or on request of any authorizing or permanent select com-
15 mittee of the Senate or of any 5 members thereof, shall
16 submit”.

17 (b) DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION; ENFORCEMENT.—
18 Section 2954 of such title is amended—

19 (1) by striking “An Executive” and inserting
20 “(a) SUBMISSION OF INFORMATION.—An Execu-
21 tive”; and

22 (2) by adding at the end the following:

23 “(b) DEADLINE.—An Executive agency shall submit
24 the information requested by a committee under sub-
25 section (a) not later than 45 days after the committee re-

1 requests the information, or not later than such alternative
2 deadline as the committee may specify in its request.

3 “(c) ENFORCEMENT.—A committee, or any 7 mem-
4 bers thereof (in the case of a committee of the House of
5 Representatives) or any 5 members thereof (in the case
6 of a committee of the Senate), which is aggrieved by a
7 violation of this section by an Executive agency may file
8 an action in the appropriate district court of the United
9 States for such injunctive and declaratory relief as may
10 be appropriate.”.

11 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
12 this section shall apply with respect to requests made on
13 or after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
