(b) AEROTROPOLIS TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM DEFINED.—Section 1301(c) of SAFETEA-LU (23 U.S.C.
101 note) is amended by adding at the end the following:
"(4) AEROTROPOLIS TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM.—The term 'aerotropolis transportation system'

means a planned and coordinated multimodal freight
and passenger transportation network that, as determined by the Secretary, provides efficient, sustainable, and intermodal connectivity to a defined region
of economic significance centered around a major
airport.".
