Ms. KENDRA S. HORN of Oklahoma (for herself and Mr. COLE) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Small Business

A BILL

To establish the Native American Outreach Program of the Small Business Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Native American Busi-
5 ness Outreach Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIVE AMERICAN OUTREACH PROGRAM.**

7 The Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 631 et seq.) is
8 amended—

9 (1) by redesignating section 49 (15 U.S.C. 631
10 note) as section 50; and

1 (2) by inserting after section 48 (48 U.S.C.
2 657u) the following:

3 **“SEC. 49. NATIVE AMERICAN OUTREACH PROGRAM.**

4 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator shall estab-
5 lish and carry out a Native American Outreach Program
6 to provide assistance to—

7 “(1) Native American communities, including
8 Alaska Natives and Native Hawaiians; and

9 “(2) small business concerns owned by individ-
10 uals in those communities or Indian tribes.

11 “(b) ASSISTANCE.—In carrying out the Native Amer-
12 ican Outreach Program, the Administrator may—

13 “(1) provide training and educational outreach
14 through business development workshops and entre-
15 preneurial classes to small business concerns owned
16 by Indian tribes or Native Americans, including
17 Alaska Natives and Native Hawaiians;

18 “(2) hold Tribal consultations to solicit input
19 and provide interested parties an opportunity to dis-
20 cuss potential modifications to programs of the Ad-
21 ministration, including the program under section
22 8(a) and the HUBZone program under section 31;
23 and

24 “(3) provide such other assistance as the Ad-
25 ministrator may determine necessary to assist Na-

1 tive American communities to implement economic
2 and business development strategies and actions to
3 improve entrepreneurship and long-term job growth.

4 “(c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
5 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
6 \$5,000,000 for each of fiscal years.”.

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
